


Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD)
&
Sacramento City Teachers Association (SCTA)

**2021 Summer Program
May 19, 2021**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is between the Sacramento City Unified School District ("District" or "SCUSD") and the Sacramento City Teachers Association ("SCTA"), collectively "the Parties", regarding the 2021 Summer Program.

- I. Per SCTA CBA 12.7.2.1, "the per session rates for K-12 summer school shall be 1/1080 of Class B, Step 4. (\$54,576/1080 = \$50.53)"
- II. For the 2021 Summer Program only, SCTA represented employees shall be compensated at the rate of \$80.00 per hour.
- III. The K-8 Program will run from June 28, 2021-July 30, 2021 (Freedom Schools will run through August 6, 2021). The hours for staff shall be 8 am to 12 pm. The focus will be on Social Emotional Learning (SEL) and small group tutoring. *ESY teachers will work 4.5 hours; training will occur week*
- IV. High School Programs will run within the time frame of June 21, 2021-July 23, 2021. Summer at City Hall may *of* include additional hours for student presentations up to July 27, 2021. The hours and responsibilities will be *June 21, 2021* determined by each site's administrator driven by the particular needs of the site.
- V. Extended School Year (ESY) will run June 28, 2021 – July 23, 2021. The hours are to be 8 am-11:30 am.
- VI. In the event there are fewer positions than teachers who have the appropriate credential and who are interested, assignment will be determined by the following:
 - a. School
 - b. Seniority within the District
- VII. Non-precedent Setting. This Agreement is limited specifically to the 2021 Summer Program and is non-precedent setting.
- VIII. Expiration Date. This Agreement shall expire in full without precedent on the last day of the 2021 Summer Program.
