Re: Continuing Negotiations on Returning Students to our Schools

Dear Mr. Fisher:

This letter follows the negotiations sessions between the District and the Sacramento City Teachers Association (“SCTA”) where we have discussed the negotiable effects of returning our students to our school sites for purposes of one-on-one in-person special education assessments for students and outdoor athletic competition. We would like to resume the discussion first initiated this fall and schedule dates for negotiations around the effects of reopening our District schools for in-person instruction when permitted under the Governor’s COVID-19 Tier Framework and the Sacramento County Public Health Department.

The District’s negotiations team is available to meet with SCTA’s negotiation team the week of February 22-26, 2021, anytime after 3:00 p.m. Please let me know by end of day Thursday, February 18, 2021, which of these dates will work for the SCTA bargaining team.

Our students have been learning away from our school sites since March 16, 2020. It is critically important that we continue our work to bring them back to in-person learning as soon as we are able to after our state and local health officials determine it is safe.
