

SCUSD Learning Options Survey Summary

The survey was available in English, as well as in Spanish, Hmong, Chinese, and Vietnamese for parents/guardians. The survey response window started on July 28, 2020, and closed on August 10, 2020.

The board should be aware of the survey results because they provide important parent/guardian feedback about their initial thoughts on the learning environment for the 2020-2021 school year. Though SCUSD is beginning the school year in distance learning only, there will hopefully be a potential point where other blended learning models may become options for our families. The survey solicited feedback about how parents/guardians would like their students to participate in school when it is safe to return to campuses.

During the survey window we received 22,952 unduplicated parent/guardian responses, which represents approximately a 56% response rate. We were able to personally identify 20,966 students (91%) of the 22,952 responses received from their parents and guardians based on the demographic data collected on the survey and validation techniques employed by the District.

Some the data highlights include:

- Approximately 68% of parents/guardians preferred blended learning or in-person learning if state and county health officials have deemed it safe to return to school
- Approximately 47% of parents/guardians indicated that the live instruction is the most important part of distance learning
- Approximately 80% of parents/guardians reported that their students have a computer available for distance learning
- Approximately 82% of parents/guardians specified that they have access to internet service
