

Addendum to Safely Reopening Schools to In-Person Instruction/Services Memorandum of Understanding dated March 20, 2021

Concerning Positive Covid-19 Tests and Cohorts

Between

Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD)

&

Sacramento City Teachers Association (SCTA)

April 12, 2021


When an individual cohort of a class has a student with a positive Covid-19 test, that cohort will be quarantined for 14 days consistent with guidance from CDPH and SCDPH and the District's Return to Health Plan. The class' other cohort will not be quarantined if there are no exposures within that cohort. In this situation, the teacher may elect to work remotely with the use of a substitute, or if she/he so chooses, may take a quarantine leave of absence pursuant to CBA Article 9.3.11.

Outreach from the principal or school administrator will follow the script attached as Appendix B.
