MOU- COVID-19 In-Person Initial English Language Learner Assessments

October 29, 2020

Proposal

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is between the Sacramento City Unified School District (District) and the Sacramento City Teachers Association (SCTA), collectively "the Parties," regarding conducting in-person initial English Language Learner Assessments while the District is in a distance learning model.

- 1. Initial English Language Learner assessments are required by law and state guidance. Beginning November 2, 2020, District employees will begin conducting these assessments inperson.
- 2. The Parties agree to follow health and safety guidelines as recommended by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Sacramento County Public Health (SCPH), and included in the District's Guidelines for Essential In-Person Assessments (Guidelines) contained within Section C of the District's Counter-Proposal regarding Special Education In-Person Assessments passed on October 29, 2020.
- 3. This MOU addresses only in-person initial English Language Learner assessments as set forth in this MOU for the 2020-2021 school year while the District is in a distance learning model and does not preclude continued discussions between the District and SCTA on other working conditions related to the reopening of schools.
- 4. This MOU expires on June 30, 2021, unless the Parties mutually agree to extend it.
